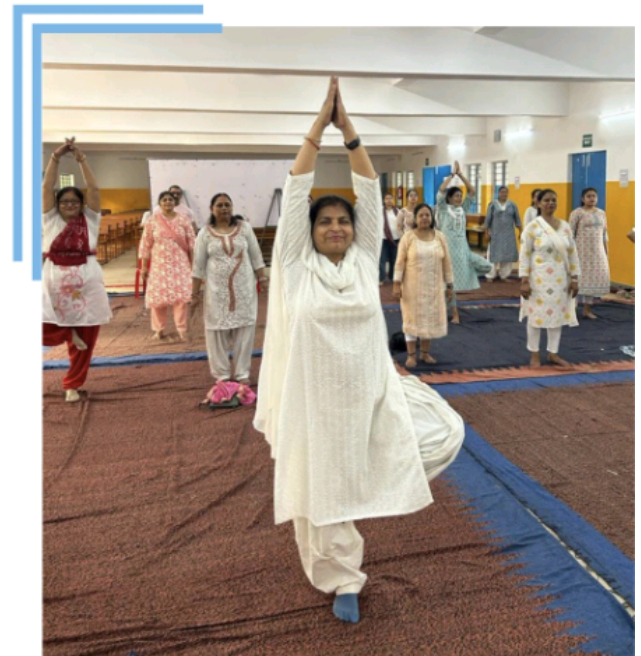
RABINDRANATH JAYANTI

Teachers are also advised to maintain a favourable environment where the child is free to ask questions to their teachers. The workshop equipped the children so that they could handle the ‘not-so-positive events in life’ in a better way. It pointed out the need to inform them about potentially dangerous situations, without causing any anxiety.

The Sohrai Paintings, an indigenous mural art found near the Hazaribagh region of Jharkhand, have attracted attention nationally and internationally. These paintings have beautiful motifs depicting geometric shapes, animals, flowers, plants, and other forms related to nature. Lord Shiva is also portrayed as Pashupati, the lord of the animals. This is a continuous ancient practice in which the tribal/local women paint their mud houses using natural colours derived from clay found in the region. The program was conducted under our Co-ordinator Ma'am, Reeta Mishra, and the Moderator, Teacher Samar Ghosh. This workshop aimed to exercise and demonstrate the use and mastery of the elements of "Tribal Art" and to use materials, tools, and processes used by the tribal people to design their artworks. It also aimed to demonstrate the understanding of art theory by applying the practical methodology to the task and describing, analyzing, and interpreting created artwork.

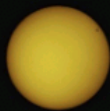

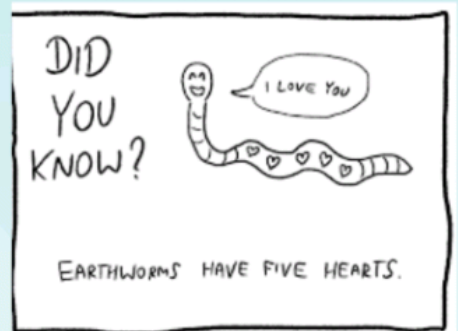
